

Early: Pseudepigrapha: *The Life of Adam and Eve, ca.* AD 2nd century; *Slavonic Enoch, ca.* AD 2nd century

Origen (AD 185–254) 1st to tie to Ezek. 28; Tertullian (AD 160–225); Cyprian (AD 200–258); Gregory Thaumaturgus; Gregory Nazianzen; Gregory of Nyssa; Jerome; the majority from Augustine to Gregory the Great (AD 590–604).




Delitzsch: "antitype of the devil and the type of the antichrist."


Isaiah Begins His Ministry, 740–739 BC Dies After 681 BC Babylon Doesn't Invade Until 605 BC






Babylon in Time









- 1. God is bringing an army against Babylon. Isa. 13:2-5
- 2. This battle is described as "The Day of the Lord." Isa. 13:5–16
- 3. One enemy is the Medes, which causes some to think this is historical. The modern group that lives in their territory is the Kurds. Isa. 13:17–18
- 4. The destruction is total, compared to Sodom and Gomorrah. Isa. 13:19–22

Herodotus, Histories, 1:191 (450 B.C.)

"... he (Cyrus) conducted the river by a channel into the lake ... and so he made the former course of the river passable by the sinking of the stream. When this had been done, the Persians who had been posted for this very purpose entered by the bed of the river Euphrates into Babylon, the stream having sunk so far that it reached about to the middle of a man's thigh ... those Babylonians who dwelt in the middle did not know that they had been captured ..."

The Ancient Near East Texts Relating to the Old Testament, 315-16.

Without any battle ... sparing Babylon ... any calamity. ... I am Cyrus ... king of Babylon. ... When I entered Babylon ... under jubilation and rejoicing ... troops walked around Babylon ... in peace, I did not allow anybody to terrorize (any place) of the [country of Sumer] and Akkad. I strove for peace in Babylon ... and in all his (other) sacred cities. ... I returned to (these) sacred cities on the other side of the Tigris, the sanctuaries of which have been in ruins for a long time, the images which (used) to live therein and established for them permanent sanctuaries.

The Ancient Near East Texts Relating to the Old Testament, 315-16.

I (also) gathered all their (former) inhabitants and returned (to them) their habitations. Furthermore, I resettled ... unharmed, in their (former) chapels, the places which make them happy. May all the gods whom I have resettled in their sacred cities ask daily Bel and Nebo for a long life for me ... all of them I resettled in a peaceful place ... ducks and doves, ... I endeavoured to fortify/repair their dwelling places . . .

Babylon's History After 539 B.C.

- Herodotus gives Babylon's measurements (450 B.C.)
- Alexander the Great visits and dies in Babylon (323 B.C.)
- Seleucus seizes Babylon (312 B.C.)
- Strabo pronounces Babylon's hanging gardens as one of "seven wonders of the world" (25 B.C.)
- Babylonians present on Pentecost (Acts 2:9)
- Talmud promulgated from Babylon (A.D. 500)
- Haukal mentions Babylonian village (A.D. 917)
- Babylon known as "Two Mosques" and "Hilah" (A.D. 1100)

What the Bible Teaches About the Destruction of Babylon

Key Question: Has this happened yet or is it yet future?

Isa. 14:9, "Hell [Sheol] from beneath is excited about you, to meet you at your coming; It stirs up the dead for you, all the chief ones of the earth; It has raised up from their thrones all the kings of the nations.

Isa. 14:10, "They all shall speak and say to you: 'Have you also become as weak as we? Have you become like us?

Isa. 14:11, "Your pomp is brought down to Sheol, and the sound of your stringed instruments; The maggot is spread under you, and worms cover you."


