**Ex. 9:15, “Now if I had stretched out My hand and struck you and your people with pestilence, then you would have been cut off from the earth.”**

**Lev. 26:25, “And I will bring a sword against you that will execute the vengeance of the covenant; when you are gathered together within your cities I will send pestilence among you; and you shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy.”**

**Deut. 28:21, “The LORD will make the plague cling to you until He has consumed you from the land which you are going to possess.”**

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**1 Kings 8:37, “When there is famine in the land, pestilence or blight or mildew, locusts or grasshoppers; when their enemy besieges them in the land of their cities; whatever plague or whatever sickness there is;”**

**Jer. 27:8, “ ‘And it shall be, that the nation [Israel] and kingdom which will not serve Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and which will not put its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation I will punish,’ says the LORD, ‘with the sword, the famine, and the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.’ ”**

**Jer. 27:13, “Why will you die, you and your people, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, as the LORD has spoken against the nation that will not serve the king of Babylon?”**

**Psa. 91:5, “You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day,”**

**Deut. 28:67, “In the morning you shall say, ‘Oh, that it were evening!’ And at evening you shall say, ‘Oh, that it were morning!’ because of the fear which terrifies your heart, and because of the sight which your eyes see.”**
