




1. Apostasy – Judges 6:1 – ONE verse **Discipline – Judges 6:1b–6–––FIVE verses** 2. 3.

Part 2: The story of the first king of Israel, Judges 9

Deliverance – Judges 6:7–8:35–NINETY-FOUR verses
